**Adaptation Between the Pressure and the Wind Field in Meso- and Small-scale Motions** Aug 20 2021 It is pointed out that in addition to the so-called geostrophic adaptation in a large-scale motion, there is an adaptation between the pressure and the wind field in meso- and small-scale motions. Scale analysis shows that in the

A quasi-balanced state exists between the inertial force (velocity advection), the coriolis force and the pressure gradient force. The progression from disturbance to restoration of a quasi-balanced state is known as an adaptive process and the evolution in a quasi-balanced state a quasi-steady process.
