The second evaluation as team leaders showed that 21% did not change the elements responsible for chest compressions every 2' (50% in error reduction rate); 36% led to delays in the application of shocks (57% in error reduction rate); 7% did not restart chest compressions (22% in error reduction rate) and the results obtained for the 4th error (0%), showed that all the elements administered therapy appropriately (43% in error reduction rate). The overall results show an improvement in quality of 175% for change of compression givers, 800% for shock delivery, 30% for resumption of chest compressions, and 75% for adequate administration of therapy.CONCLUSIONSIn this study, the use of templates to register the support given during cardiac arrest scenarios for ACLS training promoted an increment of improvement/quality in the acquisition of knowledge by professionals, reducing the rate of fatal errors. It is our intention to incorporate this protocol into real cardiac arrest scenarios of and ACLS in the hospital environment. In the near future, we aim to integrate this protocol in emergency trolleys so it is used in real cases of in-hospital cardiac arrest to promote systems for evaluating the quality of these procedures and investigate the results obtained in in-hospital cardiac arrest occurrences.It is also our purpose to continue this research in order to increase the number of individuals of the target population, with a view to acquire more comparative elements, making the results more robust.Key words: template, advanced life support, cardiac arrest.
